Active ingredients:

Purpose

Menthol 0.44%.....	External analgesic / Anti-itch
Zinc Oxide 20.6%.....	Skin protectant / Anorectal astringent

Uses: A moisture barrier that prevents & helps heal skin irritations from:
■ urine ■ diarrhea ■ perspiration ■ fistula drainage ■ feeding tube site leakage
■ wound drainage (peri-wound skin) ■ minor burns ■ cuts ■ scrapes ■ itching

Warnings: For external use only ■ Not for deep or puncture wounds ■ Avoid contact with eyes ■ Keep out of reach of children ■ In case of accidental ingestion contact a physician or poison control center immediately ■ If condition worsens or does not improve within 7 days, consult a doctor.

Directions: Cleanse skin gently with mild skin cleanser. Pat dry or allow to air dry. Apply a thin layer of Calmoseptine Ointment to reddened or irritated skin 2-4 times daily, or after each incontinent episode or diaper change to promote comfort and long lasting protection.

Inactive ingredients: calamine, chlorothymol, glycerin, lanolin, phenol, sodium bicarbonate, and thymol in a suitable ointment base
